Here are reasons why we need **your** help...

Stresses at home can turn into child abuse – every year more than 3.6 million child abuse reports are made involving 6.6 million children. We provide our families in Montgomery County with knowledge and skills to communicate and deal with day-to-day personal challenges. Nationally, more teenagers and young adults die from suicide than all other diseases combined. We teach kids their self worth in order to help prevent suicide. In 2017, we provided 4,307 nights of safe and comfortable sleep to teens that may be experiencing homelessness, and we provided a safe haven to battered and abused children. Each year approximately 17,500 youth enter sex trafficking in the U.S. Our counselors teach our children to love themselves and see the child we see.
